This term our class theme is *All About Me!* Our topic will help us to get to know our new classmates and celebrate our similarities and differences. We will find out about how we have changed and how our body works. We will also explore our emotions and talk about what being a good friend looks like.

For your home learning project, you can choose one of the following tasks:

- Find an old photo of you as a baby or very young child. Compare it to a much more recent photo and have a look at all the ways you have changed. With the help of an adult or older sibling, write down your ideas. Adults can help by asking questions. You could also find photos of senior members of the family as children!
- Make a family photo frame of comparative photographs from the past and present. E.g.: me when I was a baby, me now. My Grandma when she was young, my grandma now etc.
- Use some paint to make handprints of everyone's hands in your family. You can then cut them out. Can you put them in order of size, from the smallest handprint to the largest handprint? If you don't have any paint, you could draw around your hands instead!
