
## Year 5 Design and Technology

needles

cotton wool
ribbons








We had to sew two pieces of material together and put stuffing inside.





We then designed and labelled our stuffed toys.

We chose to use either a butterfly or round design as we had difficulties cutting through the thick material.









We followed our design by joining the fabric using a running stitch.

We practised using a blanket stitch, however as most of us had not sewn before, we decided to use a running stitch on our final design.









## What went well:

The running stitch to join the material together.

Attaching buttons using needle and thread.

The final outcome is colourful and fit for purpose.

Putting the stuffing inside.

## Tricky parts:

We found cutting fabric really difficult.

We found threading the string through the needle very challenging

## Next time we would:

Make larger soft toys without using a pre cut template.
